ART EXPRESSION, INC. AWARDED SUPPORT FROM PITTSBURGH CHILD GUIDANCE FOUNDATION, BLICK ART MATERIALS AND NATIONAL ENDOWMENT FOR THE ARTS

Pittsburgh, PA - Art Expression, Inc, is partnering with local and national sponsors to provide programming for Pittsburgh area youth after-school and in homeless shelters. These partners include Pittsburgh Child Guidance Foundation, Blick Art Materials and the National Endowment for the Arts.

The Pittsburgh Child Guidance Foundation has awarded Art Expression, Inc. a grant for \$5,000 to provide 24 workshops in four local homeless shelters. The shelter partners for this project include Womanspace East, Sisters Place, Sojourner's House, and Auberle's 412 Youth Zone.



Art Expression, Inc. has refined and will be piloting an expansion of their From the HeART workshop programming. The new version provides additional focus on allowing parents and children to gain social and emotional skills. Parents will be given the opportunity to do the same art activities as their children to promote self-expression and collaboration among family members. Parents will be taught about the developmental stages of drawing and

art, giving them insight on age-appropriate materials and how to adjust for children with special needs. "Our goal is to help parents walk away with techniques to help them feel more confident making art, and healing alongside their children, as a family." says Angela Lowden, founder and executive director of Art Expression Inc.

Art supplies for these workshops have been donated through **Blick Art Materials'** annual "Give and Get" holiday drive. Customers can donate purchased art supplies to organizations like Art Expression, Inc. in exchange for a special store coupon during

the holidays. The 2018 holiday season was the 5th year for this collaboration between Blick Art Materials and Art Expression, Inc. finishing with a record-breaking total of \$6932.98 in supplies, rivaling collections in places like Chicago and Manhattan.

The Homeless Children's Educational Fund (HCEF) continues to support Art Expression as a collaborative partner. Since 2012, Art Expression, Inc. has provided it's From the HeART arts workshops in conjunction with HCEF's Building Blocks Afterschool Program. HCEF has provided Art Expression workshops in many area homeless shelters including those we will partner with for this grant. The HCEF staff has also supported our staff in learning how best to understand and serve homeless mothers and children. Although HCEF will not take an active role in this project, they have promised to continue their advisory and supportive role to the Art Expression staff members work with local homeless populations.

The National Endowment for the Arts has awarded Art Expression, Inc. a \$10,000 grant to support after-school arts enrichment programming in the Trinity Area School District, Charleroi Area School District, and Central Greene School Districts during the 2018-2019 school year.

Matching funds for this NEA grant have been provided by the Community Foundation of Greene County and UBS Global Wealth Management. The support of \$2,500 from the Community Foundation of Greene County was made possible by grants from the Peters Family Memorial Fund and the Rotary Club of Waynesburg Charitable Fund. UBS Global Wealth Management also provided \$2,500. To date, these organizations have contributed a total of \$5,000 in matching funds.

Each school district served by this NEA grant has the opportunity to choose from among Art Expression's specialty programs. Options include Art Expression's flagship program, Creative pARTners, as well as themed variations that offer instruction in a variety of topics. These specialty programs include STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art, and math) programming such as EcoSmART, StART Growing, ARTchitecture: Building Bridges, ARTmostphere: Weather, ARTletic, ARTistic Dreamers and the ARTvenures in History series. All the classes explore metaphors that relate to the students' lives as expressed through their art projects.

Art Expression, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization providing fully inclusive after-school program, offered free of charge to students, that focuses on developing social and emotional learning through the arts in the Pittsburgh area.
